### **Summary of Course Contents**

This course is an introduction to clinical dermatology. It introduces the student to clinical presentation of common dermatoses, their manifestations and its management also to recognize the primary and secondary skin lesions and their relation to systemic diseases.

### **Course Objectives**

1. describe the clinical presentation of skin lesion.
2. reach morphological diagnosis of primary & secondary skin lesion.
3. interpret and correlate the dermatological findings in relation to systemic illness.
4. know how to confirm the diagnosis & to treat common skin diseases.

### **Methodology**

Students spend three (3) hours every week for 12 weeks in tutorial form with slide presentation. For the total of tutorials see the attached sheet.
