SALMAN T. AL-SEDAIRY was born on 6 March, 1954. He is an Associate Professor at the College of Architecture and Planning, King Saud University, Saudi Arabia and currently the Chairman of the Board for the Saudi Society of urban sciences . He previously served as Director of Housing and as a General Director of Projects for the Ministry of Interiors (1978-1985); Director of Research Center, College of Architecture and Planning, King Saud University (1989), Dean of the College of Architecture and Planning, King Saud University, Riyadh from 1995-1997.

Dr. Al-Sedairy is the author of several books and articles on architecture and project management. He has a Bachelor's degree in Architecture from King Saud University, a Master's in Architecture and Urban Design from the University of Washington, USA (1978) and a Ph.D. in Project Management from Sheffield University, UK (1985).
