

Lungs: Difficulty in breathing, cough (time and character), hoarseness, wheezing, hemoptysis, pain in chest.

Heart: Cyanosis, edema, history of heart murmurs or "heart problems," ability to keep up with other children in active play, shortness of breath, chest pains

Gastrointestinal: Appetite, nausea, vomiting (relation to feeding, amount, character), abdominal pain, distention, jaundice, blood in stool

Genitourinary: Frequency, dysuria, hematuria, character of urinary stream, bedwetting, urethral or vaginal discharge, menstrual history if appropriate

Extremities: Weakness, deformities, difficulty in moving extremities or in walking, joint pains or swelling.

Neurologic: Headaches, dizziness, in coordination, convulsions

Skin: Rashes
