

MRCPath Haemostasis Training and Update

This course is primarily for haematologists in training who are studying for Membership of the RCPATH, although it may also be of interest to Biomedical Scientists and those in the pharmaceutical and diagnostics industries. A series of lectures and tutorials will be provided by a faculty including experts from a variety of UK institutions. Topics will include: laboratory investigation of bleeding disorders and thrombo-

philia, management of haemophilia and von Willebrand's disease, paediatric haemostasis, TTP, antiphospholipid syndrome, management of an anticoagulant service and point of care testing. Data interpretation will be included in some of the topics and there will be practice with multiple choice questions.
