# Pindolol

\ Is a nonselective β-adrenergic blocking agent with high ISA, no membrane stabilizing activity, and moderate lipid solubility, hepatic dysfunction.

#### PHARIMACOKINETIC

Pindolol is almost completely (95%) absorbed orally, with peak plasma concentrations range from 15 to 38 ng/IVII

### CAUTIONS:

Pindolol may cause bradycardia, claudication, hypotension, syncope, tachycardia, fatigue, headache, dizziness, sleep disturbances, depression, tremors, diarrhea, constipation, abdominal discomfort, impotence and pronchospasm.

  half-life is 3 to 4 hours

## Dosage

The usual adult dose is 5mg orally twice daily with incremental increases by 10mg/day every 3 to 4 weeks to achieve blood pressure control to a maximum daily dose of 60 mg.
