Case Statistics as of 20 March 2006

Number of cases either under investigation or waiting preparation and referral to IC: **716***

Number of cases under investigation by inspectorate: **432**

Number of cases under investigation by correspondence (by investigation case managers): **70**

Number of full cases awaiting preparation and referral to IC: **52** (at least 20 of these are lengthy and complex)

Number of summary cases awaiting preparation and referral to IC: **86**

Number of cases heard in March: **70**

Number of cases scheduled for April: **49**

Number of cases scheduled to date for May : **41**

** This figure does not include the cases in the system that are purely health related with no associated misconduct.*
