Listening & Speaking:

- 1- Improve discussion skills by participation in class discussions.
- 2- Express an opinion.
- 3- Interview speakers in order to research a topic.
- 4- Prepare and conduct oral presentations on assigned topics.
- 5- Take notes on the main idea and limited details of a presentation in English.
- 6- Explain the main idea and some details of a documentary or radio or television new story.
