Anna Robinson-Pant is Professor of Education at the School of Education and Lifelong Learning, University of East Anglia. She holds the UNESCO Chair for Adult Literacy and Learning for Social Transformation, a collaborative research, training and policy-focused partnership with universities in Nepal, Ethiopia, the Philippines, Malawi and Egypt. She has conducted participatory research for many years, particularly in Nepal where she was based with NGO and Government education programmes. Since moving into UK higher education, she has been active in developing methodological approaches to researching across languages and cultures, including running an advanced doctoral course on participatory research.

Rafif A. Hakiem is an Assistant professor at EDU/KSU and a visiting fellow with UEA in the UK. Her main research interest is in Islamic Aesthetic and Spirituality within society and education. She joined LGD/UNESCO as a result of her research interest in issues of education in developing countries and the visual participatory transformative approach to research. Her work during her doctoral research with young women in Saudi Arabia has raised a specific interest in the dynamics of Gender and she continues to research with in this area. Her current work focuses on Saudi women's academic identity.
