


The Reproductive Structure of Flowering Plants:







Fruit

A seed develops from the ovule after fertilization of the egg in the ovule








Compound-Aggregate

Many ovaries derived from a single flower




Strawberry Flower




Aggregate Fruit Many one-seeded achenes produced by a single flower.




Each seed-bearing drupelet from the ovary of one pistillate flower.


