Chief Complaint

- 35 years old female patient.
- Seeking second opinion regarding tooth #11.





Dental History

- Orthodontic treatment about 5 years ago followed by fixed retainer in the upper anterior teeth.
- Three months, she started to have a moderate, intermittent, pulsating pain in tooth # 11.
- Consultation with a dentist, who advised her to extract the tooth and replace it with implant due to the poor prognosis

- Medical History: ASA I
- Clinical Examination showed intact crown (no discoloration) with fixed retainer (in teeth #11& 21).
- The tooth was tender to percussion but not palpation.
- A cold test with Endo-Frost spray elicited normal response.
- Periodontal exams confirmed normal probing depth (i.e., <3 mm) all around the tooth and normal physiologic mobility.
