Chief Complaint

- 45 years old female patient.
- Referred from prosthodontist for possible conventional Re-tx. and assessment of tooth #21







Dental History

- Root Canal treatment performed on Teeth # 11, #21,
 and # 22 > 10 yrs
- Those teeth were a symptomatic and restored with post and core & crown.
- Patient is not happy from the esthetic appearance of the crowns.

- Medical History : ASA I
- Clinical Examination: crown on the upper anterior teeth with poor contour and esthetic.
- The teeth were a symptomatic, tender to percussion but not palpation.
- Tooth #21 didn't respond the cold test and was tender to percussion but not palpation.
- Periodontal exams confirmed normal probing depth (i.e.,
 3 mm) all around the tooth and normal physiologic mobility.
