Written assignment (15% of final mark)

You will be divided into <u>4 groups</u> (2 students). Each group will work together as a team. The purpose of this assignment is for you to understand the implementing, designing, evaluating, management and improvement of nutrition programs. You should explicitly focus your work on a particular group of the population, describe the content of the program of work aimed at achieving change in the target population, and show how you will monitor and evaluate the program of work.

Developing the program of work:

- Describe the steps you will go through to develop and deliver your program of work. Include a detailed plan of work.
 - *Name the program*
 - State the aims and objectives of the program
 - Define the population and target group in which the program will be developed and define a target for your program of work. Show how it is SMART
 - Rational for the choice of the program(problem description, situation of country) "include statistic, graphic"
 - Describe the steps you will go through to develop and deliver your program of work. Include a detailed plan of work
 - Implementation of program (funding_venues_workers_facilities _approval_need assessment _stakeholders_partners_ integration with other programs _ services that will provide in the program "new services or modified the current services in current program"_ program activities _program timeline)
 - Monitoring and evaluation the program of work (indicators)
 - Describe in detail how you will assess:
 - Whether the program was delivered as expected according to your work plan.
 - *The impact of the program on the target, objectives and aim of the program.*
 - Suggestion for sustainability for the program

- Definition of problem/disease/ issue
- Risk groups for disease /or specify group /or why this problem is serious in these target group
- Consequences of the problem
- *Prevalence of problem/issue/disease in KSA* (morbidity, mortality, cost, trend) with new statistics with references
- Compare the situation worldwide
- The reason behind it(risk factors and determinants)
- Suitable suggestions for individual/family to prevent it with respect to the society believe and habits.
