- 1. Briefly define rampant caries and list two possible causes
 - a. Sudden rapid destruction of many teeth frequently involving surfaces that are ordinarily relatively caries free.
 - b. Xerostomia, nursing, diet
- 2. List the types of erosion and specify which tooth surface each type affects
 - a. Regurgitation erosion, palatal surface of anterior teeth and occlusal and buccal surfaces of lower posterior teeth
 - b. Industrial erosion, labial surface of upper anterior teeth
 - c. Dietary erosion, labial surface of upper anterior teeth
- 3. Attrition is mechanical wear between opposing teeth
- 4. Bruxism/ parafunctional habits will cause attrition while abrasion may be caused by abrasive toothpastes, hard tooth brushes, thread biting, pipe smoking
- 5. List two examples of intrinsic enamel stain and their causes
 - a. Fluorosis, caused by excessive consumption of fluoride during tooth development
 - b. Tetracycline staining, caused by mother taking tetracycline antibiotics during pregnancy
