

- **Establish and maintain partnerships with patients:**


Maintaining Trust

Principles of Business Conduct (1/2)

Make it clear that IEEE requires fair
 dealings with all involved parties

□ Avoid conflicts of interest

□ Maintain confidentiality of

information entrusted to IEEE

 Assure that IEEE's assets are only used for IEEE purposes

 IEEE in its reports to volunteers and management

IEEE Code of Ethics: (1) *Responsibility*

To accept responsibility in making decisions

consistent with the safety, health, and welfare of the public, &

to disclose promptly factors that might endanger the public or the environment

IEEE Code of Ethics: (2) Conflict of Interest

To avoid real or perceived conflicts of

interest whenever possible, &

to disclose them to affected parties when they do exist

To be honest and realistic

in stating claims or estimates

based on available data

IEEE Code of Ethics: (6) Seeking Competence

To maintain and improve our technical competence and

to undertake technological tasks for others only if qualified by training or experience, or after full disclosure of pertinent limitations

IEEE Code of Ethics: (7) Honest Criticism

To seek, accept, and offer honest criticism

of technical work,

to acknowledge and correct errors, and

to credit properly the contributions of others

To treat fairly all persons and

to not engage in acts of discrimination based on

race, religion, gender, disability, age, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression
