- ❖ Hue and Lightness options works better with a particular color rather than all colors (Master)

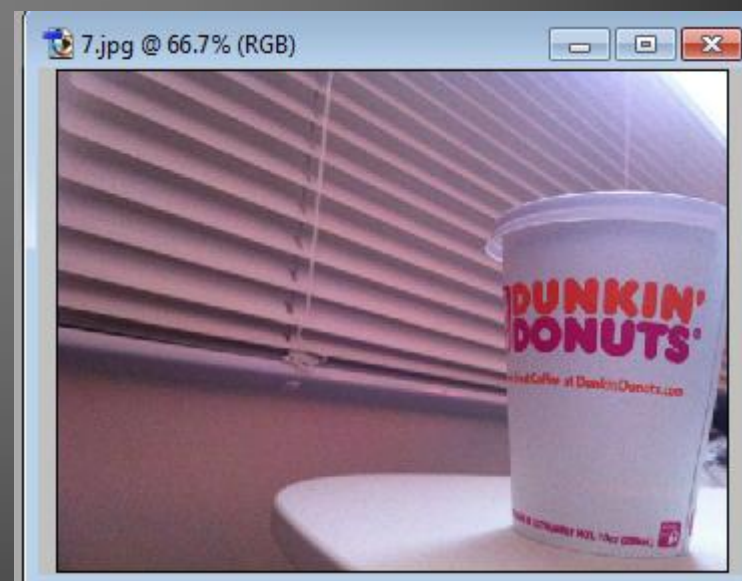
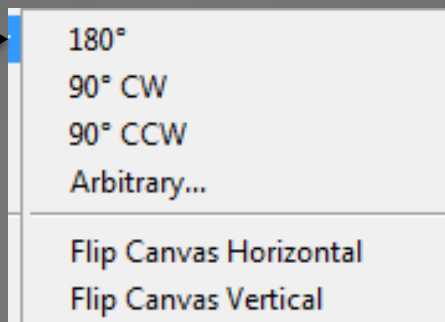
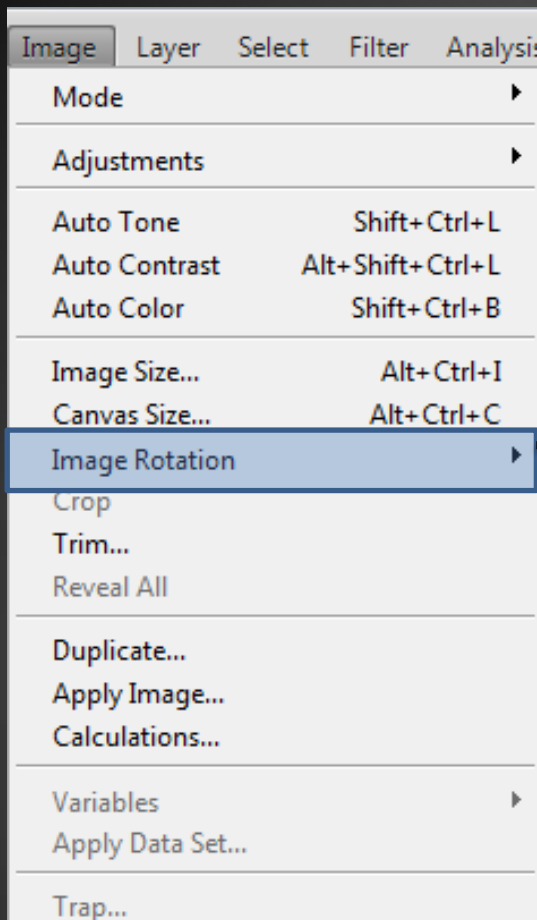
