Suffixes

- ☐ Word element placed at the end of a word or word root that changes the meaning of the word.
- ☐ Usually an indication of a pathology, condition, symptom, therapeutic or diagnostic procedure, or part of speech.
- ☐ Suffixes are divided in to two groups, those that describe diagnosis and those that describe a procedures.

Prefixes

- □ Word element attached to the beginning of a word or word root.
- ☐ Usually an indication of a number, time, position, measurement, direction, or negation.
