■ Primary sex organs:

- *Testes* in males
- *Ovaries* in females
- *These produce the (sex cells)*
 - *Sperm* in males
 - *Ovum* (egg) in females

That unite to form a baby.
- *Endocrine function also: secretion of hormones*

consists of

- Ovary
- Cervix
- Fallopian tube
- Vagina
- Uterus
- Breast

Anatomy of Breast

- **Breast**

One of two paired organs containing glands that produce milk after childbirth.

- **Lymph nodes**

Stationary collection of lymph tissue through out the body.

There are numerus lymph nodes around the breast and in the underarm (axilla).

- **Areola**

Dark pigmented area surrounding the mammary papilla (breast nipples).

- **Milk glands**

glandular tissue that produces milk after delivery of an infant.
