Anatomy of Breast

■ Breast

One of two paired organs containing glands that produce milk after childbirth.

Lymph nodes

Stationary collection of lymph tissue through out the body. There are numerus lymph nodes around the breast and in the underarm (axilla).

■ Areola

Dark pigmented area surrounding the mammary papilla (breast nipples).

Milk glands

glandular tissue that produces milk after delivery of an infant.
