

The Function of the Urinary System

- Produce urine and send it out of the body through the kidneys, Ureters , bladder, and urethra.
- Filter the blood to remove waste products product from the body (mainly urea and uric acid).
- Regulation of acid-base homeostasis
- Controlling blood volume and maintaining blood pressure
- Regulation of electrolyte balance (e.g. sodium, potassium and calcium)
