2. Click on export
3. Select General > Archive File, then click Next
4. Make sure that the assignment is checked.
5. Choose a name and a location for the archive file, then click Finish.

## Uploading the assignment to Web-CAT

1. Go to <http://10.131.240.28:8080/Web-CAT/WebObjects/Web-CAT.woa>
2. Use your student ID as your Username and Password.
3. Click the Submit button next to the assignment you want to submit.
4. Click Browse, then select the archive file you want to submit.
5. Click Upload Submission.
6. Click Confirm.
7. Wait for a few seconds for Web-CAT to test your program.
8. Web-CAT will show you your grade for the submitted assignment and the mistakes you made if any.
