## Developing the program of work:

- Describe the steps you will go through to develop and deliver your program of work. Include a detailed plan of work .
  - ✤ Name the program
  - State the aims and objectives of the program
  - Define the population and target group in which the program will be developed and define a target for your program of work. Show how it is SMART
  - Rational for the choice of the program(problem description ,situation of country) "include statistic , graphic"
  - Describe the steps you will go through to develop and deliver your program of work. Include a detailed plan of work
  - Implementation of program (funding\_venues\_workers\_facilities \_approval\_need assessment \_stakeholders\_partners\_ integration with other programs \_ services that will provide in the program "new services or modified the current services in current program"\_program activities \_program timeline)
  - Monitoring and evaluation the program of work (indicators)
    - Describe in detail how you will assess:
  - Whether the program was delivered as expected according to your work plan.
  - The impact of the program on the target, objectives and aim of the program.
    - Suggestion for sustainability for the program
